

Regulations Börker Tower Tour 2019

The Börker Tower Tour 2019 is a tourist motorride that is driven from the 12th to 14th of September 2019 with machine inspection and drivers meeting on Wednesday afternoon and evening 11th of September from 16.00 hours. Every day the departure and the arrival are in Westerbork as well as the overnight accommodation.

1. The registration for this tour is only final after receipt of the total registration fee of € 200,- before 1st of August 2019.
2. The participation fee includes: 2 drinks at the drivers meeting, 3 x coffee breaks, 3 x lunch and 3 x dinner, rally sign with number, routes as requested and use of the broom wagon if desired.
3. There is the possibility to stay in a hotel or camping or. Information about the possibilities and prices can be found on the registration form.
4. On Thursday and Friday evening and Saturday afternoon it is obligatory to participate at the dinner, regardless of the accommodation location. This as part of the social aspect whatever this event is.
5. The riders confirm on their word that the motorcycle has been produced before 1948.
6. ZZ-registration numbers are not allowed.
7. Should it appear during the inspection that the motorcycle does not comply with the agreements, has technical or administrative imperfections (f.e. registration number, insurance or driving licence), participation will be refused without refunding the registration fee.
8. Wearing a yellow safety vest is mandatory because of the sometimes dark and narrow streets.
9. Because of the environment and especially because of the new paving in Westerbork after the redevelopment of the center, it is mandatory during parking on the pavement, the engine must be fitted with an oil collection mat. This can be ordered from the organisation.
10. After payment of the entry fee, the participant declares that he or she drives at his or her own risk. driving and to be familiar with the legal obligations and above rules.
11. Reimbursement of the registration fee can only taken place at urgent medical cases or family circumstances.
